3. To approval of the Minutes of the Traffic Committee Meeting held on Wednesday 3rd January 2024.

The minutes were approved and signed as a true record.

4. To receive an update on the Community Speedwatch.

Cllr Abigail Smith reported that there is a new Community Speedwatch Group, and several sessions were held in March and again in May. The May figures picked up over 100 *speeding vehicles, from several locations in the 20-mph zone. The Police sent out 45 letters, as a result from this initiative. *speeding is set as in excess of 24 mph in the 20 mph zone.

Cllr Abigail Smith gave an update on the Vehicle Recording Cameras, in which persistent offenders are reported to the police, for them to send out a warning letter. The data is also used by the police to target areas / times where speeding is an issue, for further enforcement.

With regard to vehicles speeding up to the traffic lights on New Street (A46), so they could 'make the green lights', it was agreed to request that baffles are installed, which would limit the view of the colour of the lights until the vehicle was much closer.
